African Royale (1x30) debuts with a World Premiere Sneak Peek Monday, January 30 at 9:00pm/ET, repeating Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at 9:00pm/ET throughout February.

Starring Her Imperial Highness Abimbola "Bim" Fernandez, African Royale will give viewers an inside look at her life as she navigates the contemporary cultural connections new generations of Black Americans are discovering today.

Bim, the youngest daughter of recently deceased African diplomat and diamond, oil and gold tycoon, His Excellency Deinde Fernandez, seeks her own path forward while honoring her family's legacy.

A young and vibrant millennial, Bim embodies the complexities of finding identity under the shadow of her father's royal lineage. As she fights to protect her family's £6 billion fortune, , Bim is starting over, forging ahead with her fabulous life in Los Angeles. A businessperson and owner-curator of a priceless couture collection, Bim explores ways to monetize her passion for fashion. But in a city where beauty standards and measure of success can be toxic, Bim begins to question her body image and lifestyle. She's hesitant about joining the dating scene and suspicious of people's motives as she forms new friendships.

Along her journey, Bim discovers the fun and challenges of independent life despite her royal status and recognizes that carving out a name for herself is harder than she thinks.
